

EUSH, enroute Morotai Island to assist invasion forces. Designation changed to TG 77.2. Our mission is to provide A/S and surface cover for attack force on D-Day and for as long thereafter as required.

- (d) Steaming as before, approaching Morotai Island. 0500 Task Unit 77.2.1 separated from Task Force (Attack Force) and proceeded to fire support area to the SE of Galela Bay, Halmahera I. 0715 With visibility excellent, sea calm, wind velocity about 3 knots from SW, commenced firing on target #15 (enemy personnel bivouac area). 0740 With results of fire on target 15 unobserved, shifted fire to Koemoe Koemoe Island. 0808 Completed bombardment results unknown. 0909 Rejoined Task Unit 77.2.1, later being joined by Task Unit 77.2.2 (less NASHVILLE, ABNER READ, and BUSH) in formation "Victor". Patrolling area SE of Morotai Island.
