

Attached to CINCLANT, operating independently in accordance with CINCLANT Speedletter serial 4205 dated 23 September. Proceeding to Navy Yard, Charleston, S.C., for laying up in the Inactive Fleet.

1 November - 1337(R) Underway from 33rd Street Pier, Brooklyn, N.Y., enroute Charleston, S.C. 1426(R) Conducted a four hour full power run under excellent sea conditions.

0800(R) - At Brooklyn, New York.
1200(R) - At Brooklyn, New York.
2000(R) - Lat. 37° 48' N; Long. 74° 10' W.

2 November - 0940(R) Joined destroyers RENSHAW, WELLES and HOBBY also enroute Charleston, S.C. (Commanding Officer of RENSHAW Senior Officer). 1110(R) ISHERWOOD joined the disposition. 1148(R) GANSEVOORT joined disposition. 1350(R) YOUNG joined disposition.

0800(R) - Lat. 35° 22' N; Long. 75° 02' W.
1200(R) - Lat. 34° 26' N; Long. 75° 34' W.
2000(R) - Lat. 33° 26' N; Long. 77° 15' W.

3 November - 0605(R) Sighted Charleston Lighted Whistle Buoy. 0740(R) Entered South Harbor Channel and proceeded to Navy Yard Charleston. Reported for duty to Commander Inactive Fleet, U.S. Atlantic Fleet and to Commander Charleston Group, Inactive Fleet. Undertook preparations for laying up the ship, the final status to be In Commission, In Reserve.

Demobilization of officer and enlisted personnel was carried out in accordance with existing directives. No personnel were retained for any reason who had sufficient points for release.
